**IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR INDIANS IN HONG KONG REGARDING HOAX CALLS /  
PHONE SCAMS**

It has come to our notice that hoax calls are being made to Indians in Hong Kong where the caller purports to be from Consulate General of India. The caller tells or asks the receiver a few personal details and afterwards mentions that the person being called has provided some wrong information, for example, wrong date of birth, to the Immigration authorities of Hong Kong or to Consulate General of India. The caller then asks for money to be transferred and threatens serious action in India or Hong Kong if this is not done.

2. The Consulate General of India clarifies that **NO** such calls are being made to Indians by the Consulate. If you receive such a call, you are advised not to divulge personal details nor take any action asked for by caller, such as transferring money. You are advised to note down as many details as possible of the hoax call and report the matter immediately to police as well as to Mr. Virender Sharma, Consular Officer of the Consulate, at Tel. 39709944 or E-mail: [passport@cgihk.gov.in](mailto:passport@cgihk.gov.in)
